- reflect on changes to their practice as a result of attending this course

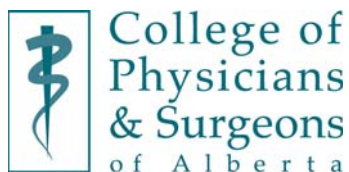
